#### *Theology Illustrated Featuring Micronesia* by Stephen Wathely.

- As for most of our students I believe they can be easily relating to this book in order to familiar themselves with some theological points which I believe can even further their understanding from what they learn in the classes. It is easy to understand and analyze those drawings.

*Talk Thru the Bible*- I remember trying to find out each books of the Bible and their purposes and messages from which they are written, I know that this book was really easy to understand.

*The 21 Irrefutable Laws of Leadership* by John C. Maxwell- I use this book for most of my classes on leadership and I believe that this is a very easy to understand as well.
