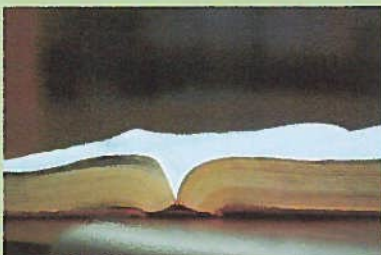

Membership Benefits

Regular members

Regular members of the group are able to check out materials, utilize the support of the library staff, and participate in free classes offered by the library and PIU faculty. Members will also receive emails and updates on new acquisitions to the collection they might find interesting as well as the bi-monthly newsletter.

Associate members

Those who sign up for the newsletter but who do not wish to participate as a regular member. Associate members are authorized newsletter and email information but not circulation privileges.

Corporate members

Churches, businesses, and corporations may become members. Organizations are entitled to any training or community education sessions offered by the library staff. Site visits are available by appointment. Individuals from those companies who are corporate members may join as regular members with all privileges at the discounted rate. Corporate members will be given public acknowledgment at the time of membership and any time additional support is offered for individual programs.
